

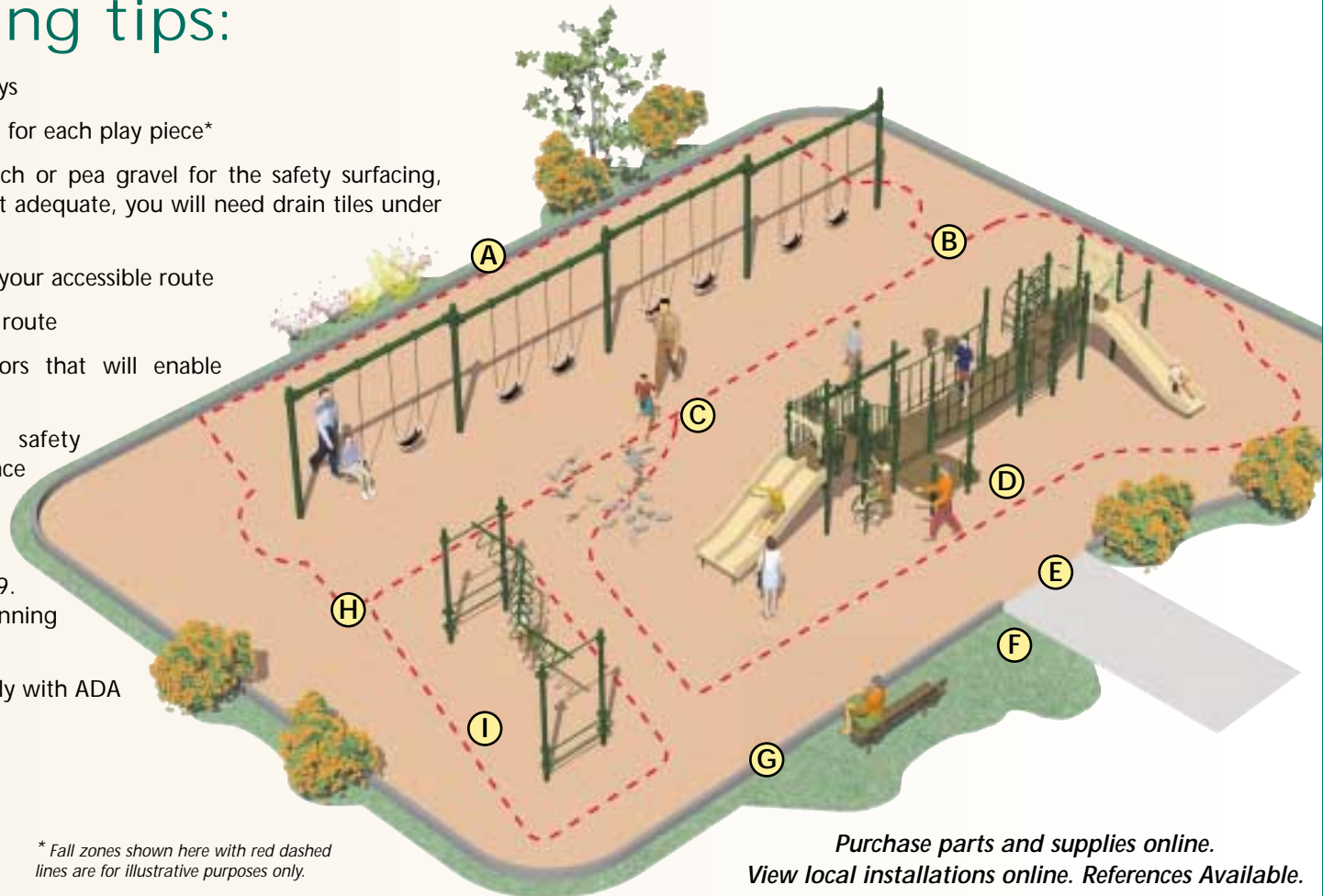
# Play area planning tips:

- (A)** For safety, place swings out of traffic pathways
- (B)** Adequate fall zone space should be provided for each play piece\*
- (C)** When using a porous material such as mulch or pea gravel for the safety surfacing, consider your drainage. If the drainage is not adequate, you will need drain tiles under the surface to keep it dry
- (D)** Transfer module should be placed closest to your accessible route
- (E)** Provide an ADA entry point on an accessible route
- (F)** Provide a bench for playground supervisors that will enable them to view entire play area
- (G)** Provide adequate border system for safety surfacing and for easy playground maintenance
- (H)** Provide and maintain ADA accessible safety surfacing to ensure compliance with ASTM F1951-99 and ASTM F1292-99. This is a very important element in planning your playground!
- (I)** Add ground level components to help comply with ADA accessibility
